The three tools of reality creation:



Desire, Expectation and Imagination

There are only these three. Even the most powerful and successful human being has no more than these three tools. The only difference between people who are able to create what they want with ease and those who can't, is how aligned each of the tools is with their goal.

A brief exploration? Pick something you have been trying to create in your life:

Notice how high your desire is.

Most likely your desire is pretty strong.

Now notice how easily you are able to vividly imagine yourself experiencing what you want.

That may already be harder to do.

And finally notice how strong your expectation is that you will experience what you desire.

That is most often the weakest component. Instead of expectation, there is often doubt. And doubt is really a negative expectation squelching hope.

You will always be able to manifest easily what you desire, when neither expectation nor imagination contradict your desire; when not only your conscious mind, but also the subconscious or unconscious levels of your being are in agreement, in other words when your soul has the same plan.

You may have also noticed that all three tools - desire, imagination and expectation - are a function of the future. We desire to have or be something in the future, we expect something to happen in the future and what we imagine is also taking place in the future. So, does our relationship with the future play a critical role in what we experience? Yes, it absolutely does!

One of our foundational principles is: "The future creates the present... against the backdrop of the past." So if you want to change something in your life, you also always need to change your personal future.
